The Be the Best You Can Be curriculum helps students learn how to manage their thoughts, emotions and behaviour so they can succeed in school and in life. It aims to create a positive, inclusive environment where every student can thrive academically, socially and emotionally.

Our focus is on:

- **A positive climate.** Building respect, responsibility and strong relationships so every student feels valued and included.
- **Emotional and social development.** Helping students develop confidence, self-regulation and the skills to manage relationships and challenges.
- **Consistency and clarity.** Setting clear expectations and supporting students to understand and meet them.
- **Targeted support.** Providing personalised help when students need additional guidance.
- **Working together.** Partnering with families and the wider community to support every student's success.

The curriculum will be assessed, in part, through the termly Behaviour Assessment Target System (BATS), which are split into four sections:

- Classroom Skills (CS)
- Behaviour (B)
- Identity (I)
- Social Skills (SS)

Half-termly assessment will also be made via the Learning Behaviour Framework at CSS.
